With specific training and expertise in clinical pharmacology, Dr. Uemura executes early clinical trials as PI at the state-of-the-art CTU (clinical trial unit) in Oita University Hospital where he leads the Clinical Pharmacology Center. Dr. Uemura has a broad background of clinical pharmacology, especially first-in-human and pharmacokinetic/pharmacodynamic research in humans to guide critical decisions in clinical practice. Not only has he served as PI or co-Investigator on various government and industry-funded phase I trials, he has 10 years of past experience in R&D as a study director and senior principal scientist at Division of Clinical Pharmacology, Merck Research Laboratories, in planning, executing and analyzing phase I programs in early clinical development. Currently he is a full professor in Oita University Faculty of Medicine and co-appointed as an adjunct professor at Osaka University Hospital Department of Medical Innovation and as Clinical Development Director at RIKEN Program for Drug Discovery and Medical Technology Platforms. In addition, Dr. Uemura serves as an Associate Editor for *Clinical and Translational Science*, an official open-access journal of American Society for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics.
